**ROSSMOOR:** All buses leave from POOL-SIDE.

**CONCORDIA and GREENBRIAR @ WHITTINGHAM:** All Buses leave from the Bus Shelter in the Parking Lot.

### **REFUND POLICY**

## **AUGUST 2018 TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION**

**August 8th.... "Mamma Mia" @ Toby's Dinner Theatre**....On the eve of her wedding, a daughter's quest to discover her father's identity brings three very different men from her mother's past back to the Greek island. Will she figure out which one is her father? Let's go and see. **Cost is 62 p.p. STAND-BY ONLY**

**August 14th...."Saturday Night Fever" @ Surfflight Theatre**....This story tells the life of Tony Manero, a talented, streetwise kid from Brooklyn who attempts to escape his dead-end life through dancing. You will hear most of the original songs from the movie like "Stayin' Alive", "How Deep is Your Love" and "More Than a Woman". We will be stopping at Buckalew's for lunch prior to this 2 p.m. show. Walking is a must from the restaurant to the theatre. **Cost is 54 p.p. STAND-BY ONLY**

**August 15th.... "Winterthur"**....Join us as we step back in time and see where history lives on in spectacular gardens and romantic landscapes, the fabulous mansion is filled with magnificent American antiques, and a nationally renowned research library. Created in the early 20th century by H.F. DuPont and his father in the spirit of 18th & 19th century European country homes. We will be stopping at the Old Country Buffet on our way home for lunch. **Cost is \$32 p.p.**

**August 21st.... "Beatles Rock the USA" @ Doolans**....The Beatles Rocked the USA immediately upon their arrival in NY on February 7, 1964. Hear our sensational Allstar tribute band hand picked from both sides of the pond. Enjoy songs like "I Wanna Hold Your Hand" along with other wonderful songs done by the Beatles. **Cost is \$52 p.p.**

**August 22nd.... "Mercer Museum"**.... Join us for this guided tour of "Racing: a Need for Speed", special exhibit, which explores the colorful history of racing in Bucks county and the nearby Delaware Valley from the footraces of the native Lenape, to the fairs and the horse tracks of the 1800's, to the auto speedways & bicycle velodromes of the 20th century. Afterwards, you can try your own skill and speed with some racing "try-its". After our time at the museum we will go to Peddlers Village for you to have lunch and time on your own. **Cost is \$15 p.p.**

**August 23rd.... "Kykuit"**....This tour will have you visiting the house and exploring its outstanding landscape and sculpture. This tour emphasizes the outdoors, bringing you through all of Kykuit's spectacular gardens including the Italian garden and Adam & Eve fountain area, as well as several terraced areas featuring classical and contemporary sculpture. You will also visit the grotto, an unusual underground" space tucked beneath the Temple of Venus. After our tour we will go to the Sunset Cove for lunch,. **WALKING IS A MUST FOR THIS TRIP. Cost is \$64 p.p.**

**August 24th..... "MUA: Water Tour"**....Let's go and learn first hand about our water supply and how it gets from the ground into our homes by our very own John Katerba (Township Historian and MUA employee). **Cost is \$5 p.p.**

**September 5th.... "Million Dollar Quartet" @ Bucks County Playhouse**.... Let's go back to December 4, 1956, when an unlikely quartet of Elvis Presley, Johnny Cash, Jerry Lee Lewis, and Carl Perkins accidentally converged on Sun Records in Memphis and made magic in the process. Let's go and see what legendary hits came from this monumental night. **Cost is \$41 p.p.**

**September 6th.... "Pioneer Tunnel Coal Mine & Train Ride"**....Our first ride will be going down into the coal mine then, we will be traveling back in time on an old-time narrow gauge steam locomotive, the Henry Clay, which was built in the 1920's. This engine will take you on a three-quarter mile ride on the original tracks around the side of Mahanoy Mountain to show you another kind of mining called strip mining. After our time here we will go to the Dutch Kitchen for lunch. It will be 52-degrees in the coal shaft. **Cost is \$35 p.p.**

**September 12th.... "Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center"**.....This wonderful museum is a companion facility to the Museum on the National Mall in Washington DC. Opened since 2003, its two huge hangers-the Boeing Aviation and the James S. McDonnell Space Hanger displays thousands of aviation and space artifacts, including a Lockheed SR-71 Blackbird, a Concorde, and the Space Shuttle Discovery. The Center also offers the Airbus IMAX Theatre and the Donald Engen Observation Tower which will give you a 360 degree view of the surrounding area. We will be stopping at the Old Country Buffet for dinner on our way home. **THIS WILL BE A LONG DAY. Cost is \$20 p.p.**

**September 18th.... "NY Yankees Ball Game"**.... Let's go out to the ball game and see the Yankees take on the Boston Red Sox. This is the first time we have been able to get these tickets. Our seats are on the Main Level, in section 233B. **Cost is \$72 p.p.**
