All Buses leave from their Community's Clubhouse.

**REGENCY:** All buses leave from the Bus Stop in the parking lot.

**ROSSMOOR:** All buses leave from POOL-SIDE.

**CONCORDIA and GREENBRIAR @ WHITTINGHAM:** All Buses leave from the Bus Shelter in the Parking Lot.

## **JANUARY 2018 TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION**

**January 17th.... "Princeton Art Museum"**....You will be on your own to enjoy this wonderful museum at your own pace. You will be able to see the "Picturing Place in Japan" exhibit that is on loan from the Gitter-Yelen Collection, along with past Museum acquisitions from that collection. Weather permitting, lunch on your own in Princeton. **Cost is \$6 p.p. Stand-by Only**

**January 31st.... "Louis Kahn Bathhouses & Benjamin Temple House"**....Our first stop will be at the Bathhouses for a guided tour of them and then our tour guide will direct us to the Benjamin Temple House where we will learn the history of this historic home which was built by Mr. Temple in the 1750's. Mr. Temple was a prosperous farmer and one of the settlers of the Ewing-Hopewell area. We will have lunch at the Temple house. **WALKING AND STEPS ARE A MUST FOR THIS TRIP.** Cost is \$30 p.p. *Stand-by Only.*

**February 6th.... "On Golden Pond" @ Bristol Riverside Theatre**....Join us for a humorous and heartwarming show about love, reconnection and family. After an unexpected relationship blooms, a family reunites during an unforgettable summer. Lunch will be at the King George Inn. **WALKING IS A MUST FROM THE RESTURANT TO THE THEATRE.** Cost is \$64 p.p.

**February 12th...."Covenhoven House"**....Join us for a guided tour of this historic home which was built between 1752-1753, by William and Elizabeth Covenhoven. This home had a very unexpected, and important visitor, British General Henry Clinton who occupied their home for 36 hours and forced the elderly Elizabeth to sleep in her milk house. Let's go and find out some more interesting facts. **WALKING IS A MUST FOR THIS TRIP. Lunch at home after the tour. Cost is \$5 p.p.**

**February 20th.... "NJ State Museum & Planetarium"**.....Your first stop upon our arrival at the museum is the planetarium to see "**Wildest Weather in the Solar System**". After the planetarium, you have time to enjoy the museum. Lunch on your own at Quakerbridge Mall. **WALKING IS A MUST FOR THIS TRIP. Cost is \$6 p.p.**

**February 26th...."Taylor-Butler House"**....We will have a guided tour of this historic home which was built in 1853 by Joseph and Mary Taylor who were first cousins of the Taylors of Middletown. This home represents the Civil War era. The home was furnished with items from the Orient and Taylor family heirlooms. **WALKING IS A MUST FOR THIS TRIP** Lunch at home after the tour. **Cost is \$7 p.p.**
