Please keep in mind that if you would like to join us on any trips you must be a Township resident 55 years of age or disabled and a member of the Senior Center.

When calling in for your trips, you may call for yourself and one other person in your community as long as the other person isn’t calling in also. You can only give two (2) names at a time, whether it is for the same trip or a different trip.

CANCELLATIONS!

To avoid having to cancel, please check your personal calendar before calling. This helps us to serve you better. However, if you must cancel a reservation, please call our office as soon as possible or at least 2 (two) weeks before the trip. Our number is (609) 443-0511.

Our answering machine is on 24 hours a day.

Please leave a message with your name, phone number and the trip date that you would like to cancel.

REMINDER:

If you can’t make our trips, whether it’s a paying one or not, we ask that you be considerate and call our office to cancel. This will enable us to call someone else to join us. If you are the only one at a location, we won’t have to make a stop and wait for someone who is not joining us. We will be able to do our job more efficiently. Thank you for your consideration.

PONDS/ENCORE/ STONEBRIDGE, RENAISSANCE @ MONROE AND CRANBURY CROSSING:
All Buses leave from their Community's Clubhouse.

ROSSMOOR: All buses leave from POOL-SIDE.

REGENCY: Buses leave from Bus Stop in Parking Lot.

CONCORDIA and GREENBRIAR @ WHITTINGHAM: All Buses leave from the Bus Shelter in the Parking Lot.

REFUND POLICY

If you need to cancel for any reason, please call us as soon as possible. Refunds are granted—without a doctor's note-when you cancel two (2) weeks prior to the trip date. Otherwise, a note is required within five (5) business days of the trip date and your seat MUST be replaced. Any and all refunds will be processed within 7-10 business days after the trip. If you contact us after this time period there will be **NO REFUNDS GIVEN!**

July 6th.... "Museum of the American Revolution".... You will be on your own to enjoy a journey through the remarkable story of America's founding and gain a deeper understanding of the people, events and ideals that gave birth to this wonderful nation. This is a brand new museum that just opened in April of 2017. Lunch is on your. **Cost is \$16 p.p. Stand-By Only**
