Brown bag your lunch and beverage to enjoy on the grounds.** Cost is \$7 p.p.

July 8th.... "Trenton Thunder Ball Game"....Take me out to the ball game. We will watch the Thunder's take on New Hampshire. PONDS/ENCORE and BOTH RENAISSANCE's: All Buses leave from Community's Clubhouse.

ROSSMOOR: ALL BUSES LEAVE **POOL-SIDE.** **REGENCY:** Buses leave from Bus Stop in Parking Lot.

CONCORDIA: ALL Buses leave from the BUS SHELTER. **PARK ACROSS THE STREET.**

WHITTINGHAM: All Buses leave from the Bus Shelter in the Parking Lot.
