## ITALIAN AMERICAN HERITAGE MONTH

OCTOBER 2024

**WHEREAS,** Italians began migrating to the United States in 1880, and today there are more than twenty-six million Americans of Italian descent in the country; and

**WHEREAS,** with more than one and a half million Italian Americans living in New Jersey, has been ranked third among states with the largest Italian American populations; and

**WHEREAS,** the Township of Monroe is home to a proud and vibrant Italian American community. Italian Americans have contributed greatly to the cultural fabric and identity by influencing the arts and education, business and government, social service, and scientific and technological advancements of the Township, State and Country; and

**WHEREAS,** October has been designated Italian American Heritage Month to celebrate the cultural heritage, achievements, and contributions Italian Americans have made in the Township of Monroe and across the state and country.
