WHEREAS, the resulting Community Energy Plan will help the Township of Monroe plan for and invest in renewable energy and to work towards a better environment for all residents by using the state’s Energy Master Plan (“EMP”) as a guide to develop sustainable strategies that increase clean energy production, reduce energy use and cut emissions.

**RESOLUTION OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING A ONE YEAR CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH
PABCO INDUSTRIES LLC

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2024, per Resolution No. R-6-2024-177, Pabco Industries LLC. was awarded the Monroe Township Grass Bags contract for a period of 1 year with the option for the Township to extend for two additional one-year periods; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2025 per Resolution No. R-8-2025-153, the Monroe Township Grass Bag contract with Pabco Industries was extended for the first one year period, from July 1, 2025 thru June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Township Clerk inquired as to the willingness of Pabco Industries LLC. to extend their current contract for a second one year extension; and

WHEREAS, the attached letter received June 25, 2026 indicates the willingness of Pabco Industries LLC. to extend the current contract from July 1, 2026 thru June 30, 2027, under the same terms, conditions and pricing contained within their original proposal and contract; and

WHEREAS, the Certified Municipal Finance Officer has determined that sufficient funds are available as set forth in Certificate No C-2400055, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the contract for Grass Bags is being extended one year to June 30, 2027 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-15 of the Local Public Contracts Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Monroe, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey that it has rendered its advice and hereby consents to the one-year extension of contract with **Pabco Industries LLC.** under the same terms, conditions and pricing within their original proposal submitted for the Monroe Township Grass Bags; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Department is hereby authorized and directed to pay Invoices for the above referenced vendor in accordance with the original terms, conditions and pricing contained within their original 2024 contract entered into between the parties.
