**ORDINANCE NO.: O-3-2018-010**

**ORDINANCE OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL  
AMENDING CHAPTER 122 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE,  
MIDDLESEX COUNTY, ENTITLED, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC"**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Council of the Township of Monroe, in the County of Middlesex, New Jersey as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 122-44, Schedule XV of the Code of the Township of Monroe, which Section establishes "*Prohibited turns at Intersections*" within the Township of Monroe shall be amended to include the following:

In accordance with the provisions of § 122-20, no person shall make a turn of the kind designated below at any of the following locations:

| <u>Name of Street</u> | <u>Direction of Travel</u> | <u>Prohibited Turn</u> | <u>At Intersection of</u> |
|-----------------------|----------------------------|------------------------|---------------------------|
| Perrineville Road     | Southbound                 | No turn on red         | Union Valley Rd.          |
| Union Valley Road     | Eastbound                  | No turn on red         | Perrineville Rd.          |
| Union Valley Road     | Westbound                  | No turn on red         | Perrineville Rd.          |

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**SECTION 3.** If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect twenty days after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.



This office has conducted an inspection of the above intersection in response to a report provided by the Monroe Township Police. Based on our inspection, and in concurrence with said report, we recommend that the Township amend the Monroe Township Ordinance related to turn prohibitions as noted:

**Ordinance # 122-44 Schedule XV: Prohibited Turns at Intersections**

To include the following description:

**Add:**

**Perrineville Road (southbound)**  
**Union Valley Road (eastbound)**  
**Union Valley Road (westbound)**

**No Turn on Red at the intersection of Union Valley Road**  
**No Turn on Red at the intersection of Perrineville Road**  
**No Turn on Red at the intersection of Perrineville Road**

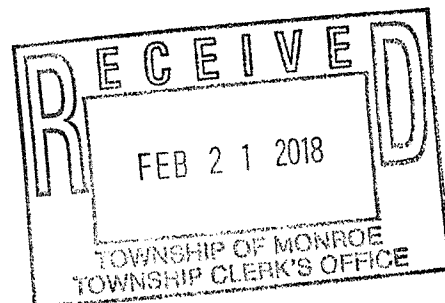

SUBJECT: Perrineville Rd./Union Valley Rd. Intersection – View Obstruction


Ma'am:

As you are aware, a traffic signal has recently been installed at the intersection of Perrineville Rd. and Union Valley Rd. and it is currently fully operational. There were also additional lanes added and the road has been restriped. It has been brought to my attention that the motorists' view is obstructed and it is difficult to see oncoming traffic when making a right turn on red at the above stated intersection.

On this date I went out to the intersection to address this matter. I observed that when the drivers are stopped at the painted solid stop line, their view to the left (perpendicular roadway) is obstructed on Perrineville Rd. (southbound), Union Valley Road (eastbound), and Union Valley Road (westbound). I have attached photographs with this Special Report which were taken from the driver's view when stopped at the above stated locations (photographs #1-3). Photograph #4 was taken from Perrineville Rd. (northbound) and that is the only side of the intersection where the view is not obstructed.


Since I am aware that this was a county project which has been completed only several weeks ago, I contacted the Middlesex County Engineer's Office and spoke with them about this matter. I was informed that this project is still in the "open" status in their files, and that changes/adjustments can be made easily. I was informed that "aerial photographs" were used when designing the intersection improvements, and that the sight angles were not visible. I advised the county engineer's office that the trees/bushes either have to be removed from the above stated locations, or if that is not feasible, "No Turn on Red" signs have to be installed. I was asked to forward my concerns/recommendations to the Monroe Twp. Engineer's Office and have the Monroe Twp. Engineer send a letter to the Middlesex County Engineer's Office with their recommendations.

I am respectfully requesting to have this concern forwarded to the Monroe Twp. Engineer's Office. As stated above, I believe that the above stated trees/bushes either have to be

removed/trimmed on three corners of the intersection or if that is not feasible, "No Turn on Red" signs have to be installed to make the intersection safer.


