ORDINANCE OF THE MONROE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 122, ARTICLE XIII
OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MONROE TO
AUTHORIZE THE POLICE TO ENFORCE TITLE 39 OF THE NEW JERSEY
MOTOR VEHICLE CODE IN REGENCY AT MONROE

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 39:5A-1 authorizes the enforcement of Subtitle 1, Title 39 of the Revised Statutes of the State of New Jersey, the Motor Vehicle and Traffic Statutes, on private property upon receipt of a written request; and

WHEREAS, Regency at Monroe Homeowners' Association, Inc. (the "Association") has filed a written request for the Township of Monroe to enforce provisions of Subtitle 1, Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, in the roadways and parking areas throughout the Regency at Monroe community a residential subdivision with ingress and egress on Spotswood-Englishtown Road and Buckelew Avenue in the Township of Monroe, County of Middlesex.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of Monroe, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 122, Article XIII of the Code of the Township of Monroe entitled "Subtitle 1 of Title 39" is hereby amended to include a new section enumerated § 122-53:

§ 122-53. Regency at Monroe

A. General parking.

- (1) All vehicles must park in designated areas and between the lines provided.
- (2) No person shall park, stop or stand a vehicle in front of a fire hydrant, driveway, or within 25 feet of a crosswalk or sideline of a street.

B. Stop intersections. The following described intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections.

Intersection	Stop Sign
All roads and aisles	As indicated on the site plan on file in the office of the Township Clerk

C. Speed limits.

- (1) The speed limit for both directions of travel on the following roadways are:

Name of Street	MPH	Limit
All roads	25	Entire Length

- (2) Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits authorized by the Department of Transportation.

D. Tow away zones. Any vehicle parked or standing as to obstruct or impede a normal flow of traffic, block entrances or exit ways, loading zones, oil fills, any grassy area, pedestrian walkway, or present in any way a safety or traffic hazard may be removed by towing the vehicle at the owner's expense.

E. That all signs, posts, or other necessary materials be installed, paid for, and maintained by the Association. All signing shall conform to the current Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-198 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-183.27.

F. Penalty. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by New Jersey Statute, every person convicted of a violation of this section or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$50 or imprisonment for a term not exceeding 15 days or both.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict; and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that this Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance with applicable law.


